Evaluation

- Evaluations were collected from 64 participants
 - 87% “strongly agreed or agreed” that the keynote speaker helped them to understand the health differences among central Michigan women
 - 85% “strongly agreed or agreed” the format for the meeting was comfortable to share information
 - 83% “strongly agreed or agreed” that they could share their thoughts and feelings with others at the meeting
